We appreciate the opportunity for Eagle Park Reservoir Company stakeholders and Board members to have taken part in the stakeholder process that lead to the development of the Camp Hale Master Plan and consideration given to the 1998 Eagle River Memorandum of Understanding (ERMOU). The following concerns were also addressed during stakeholder meetings and included in the Master Plan:

- Ensuring the ability to continue water supply development in the Camp Hale area as envisioned in the ERMOU;
- Maintaining appropriate equipment access to the stream channel to ensure unobstructed delivery of upstream augmentation releases through Camp Hale to downstream needs.
