Thank you for the opportunity to comment.

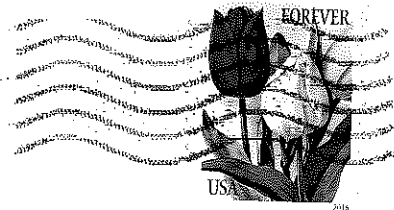
