Issues to which objection applies:

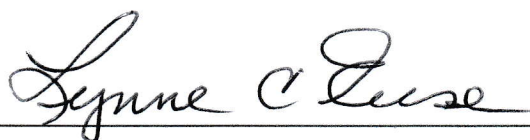
