Why is the area important from your perspective?

We hiked on on the Terror Trail during a  
wet season. It overlapped the route the sheep  
herders use to get their sheep to pasture. Our  
trail was completely obliterated with ankle-deep  
mud. We were forced off the trail to traverse the  
hillside to the north. There were lots of social  
trails.

We got up the part way and intersected the  
Terror trail again and the Mt. Biking signs.  
We did not see any indication of bikes having  
been there recently.

We used the terror trail and then a spur  
trail to access Electric Mt. We left via a  
horse track on the West side.

How would you like to see this area managed by the Forest Service and why?

+ Separate Terror trail from the Sheep travel route.

+ Decide if Mt. Bikes are using the area. If not, return the trail to foot traffic only.

+ Create a loop trail for hikers.
