Many times, I've written letters in support of non-motorized Roadless area protections. I'm writing to support Weitas as new Wilderness within the Forest Plan Revisions.

The 1.5 million acres of existing crucial roadless wildlands need more designated habitat protections.

More than ever, recent events from Idaho Fish & Game with illegally tagging wolves, shows the need for MORE protection & regulation to support non-mechanization in wilderness.

Lastly, given the push to "thin" fuel sources and reduce wildfire risks, growing exploitation from logging companies need firm limits to support last remaining roadless wildlands.

Do NOT move Cayuse Creek from

the Weitas Cr. Roadless Area.
Please prevent unreplaceable
roadless areas including Upper
N. Fork, Pot Mountain,
Weitas Cr., & Fish Creek, &
Hungry Creek. Please, NO
road building, logging, or
development of any kind. The
1.5 million acres, including
the entire roadless base on
the Nez-Pece Clearwater Forest,
needs wilderness protections.

Please keep habitat corridors &
wild rivers intact for future
generations.
