The current plan lets OSV right up to the Pacific Coast Trail over several stretches. In my experience, OSV sounds carry for miles even under the best of conditions. I would like to see corridors at least a mile on each side of the PCT where it is in OSV-accessible areas (most of it is in the areas closed to OSVs).

6) Description of connection between objections and prior comments

My prior comments related to access for snowshoe and cross-country skiers and protection from sound pollution where OSVs can operate nearby to trails or commonly used non-vehicular areas. My connection here is providing a specific request for sound protection along the Pacific Coast Trail in current OSV-accessible areas.
