On behalf of Mesa County, I respectfully request that the Forest Service consider at least a forty-five (45) day comment period for review of the Grand Mesa, Uncompangre, Gunnison National Forest ("GMUG") Preliminary Draft Plan.

Given the dates of the public open houses scheduled by the Forest Service, we find the thirty days proposed to be an inadequate time for thorough review of the draft plan, attendance of the open houses for dialogue with the Forest Service staff and completion of comments, not only for Mesa County but also for our citizenry. A longer comment period will allow more thoughtful comments from all stakeholders in this important planning process.
