We love the Salmon river, and recreate frequently in the area affected. I strongly urge the Forest Service to prevent water contamination from heavy metals and acid mine drainage, and if this is possible in the South Fork headwaters, then this project should NOT go forward. In addition, the Forest Service MUST investigate ways of storing tailings and waste rock in order to protect spawning habitat. The natural beauty, clean air and water are our GREATEST resources.
