I commend your proposed Alternative 2 as it shows you have really taken the public comments and requests into consideration.

While I realize that this plan concerns motorized vehicles, I am concerned about how you will enforce the Plan and monitor all areas of the Forest for compliance. The Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest is large. I am especially wondering how you will insure that ATVs and other motorized vehicles will not be encroaching on the non-motorized White Mountain Trailsystem. Is it possible to keep all motorized vehicles off the 200 miles of hiking trails?

I am the designated Trail Steward for the Country Club trail and every time I hike this trail I worry that I will see ATV tracks. As an organization, TRACKS maintains the White Mountain Trailsystem. Most trails have remained preserved for hiking, mountain bike and equestrian use, however some encroachment has occurred in the past. I hope this Travel Management Plan will guide motorized users of the forest to respect signs regarding non-entry for motorized users. I hope there will be consequences for ignoring non-entry signs such as confiscation of offending ATVs and fines for encroachment on the White Mountain Trailsystem trails.
