

ORDER #SJ-99-01  
CLOSURE ORDER  
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551, 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the areas, roads, and trails as described on the San Juan Travel Management Map (1994) and in this order within the San Juan National Forest, until further notice:

- (1) Using the type of vehicles ON FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS listed as restricted or "closed" as defined on the San Juan National Forest Map dated 1994, AREA TABLE Code A-F and ROAD AND TRAIL Code 1-5. [36 CFR 261.54(a)].
- (2) Using a road for commercial hauling without a permit or written authorization. [36 CFR 261.54(c)].
- (3) Operating a vehicle carelessly, recklessly, or without regard for the rights or safety of other persons or in a manner or at a speed that would endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. [36 CFR 261.54(f)].
- (4) Using the type of vehicles ON FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS listed as restricted or "closed" as defined on the San Juan National Forest Map dated 1994, AREA TABLE Code A-F and ROAD AND TRAIL Code 1-5. [36 CFR 261.55(b)].
- (5) Shortcutting a switchback in a trail. [36 CFR 261.55(e)].
- (6) Using the type of vehicles OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS listed as restricted or "closed" as defined on the San Juan National Forest Map dated 1994, AREA TABLE Code A-F and ROAD AND TRAIL Code 1-5. [36 CFR 261.56].
- (7) Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. [36CFR 261.58(g)].

The "AREA TABLE" and "ROAD AND TRAIL TABLE" is shown on attachment #1 and is made a part of this Order.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.



