I would like to add the comment we discussed last night, that once a project is determined then the public is informed and comment again requested. Also I request more emphasis on category of restricting/limiting livestock access to areas impacted by drought, etc. As a veterinarian and rancher I am not against grazing, but have seen the impacts of over-grazing esp. here in Taos Canyon (Rio Fernando.) Also have seen the problems when projects are performed without local resident input/knowledge. Also in category of fencing, be sure definitions about need for wildlife access is addressed — again up here in Taos Canyon we are fighting issue of new DOT fence built to keep cattle off roadway is totally wildlife incompatible.
