I have hunted the Angelina NF and the Davy Crockett NF for nearly 20 years. I have seen the impacts of hurricanes, droughts, and encroaching development on whitetail habitat. There are ~2% public lands in the State of Texas, and a small percentage of that is forest. National forests are a national treasure, an experience and obligation for care that is handed down generations.

There is simply no need to develop oil/gas interests in the forest. We Texans can't even get to all of the deposits in the Permian basin. I absolutely reject the need to continue wildcatting in managed and virgin national forests. This is simply not in the public interest.
