This area has been our family's backyard for 40 years. It is critical to keep it in a natural, pristine-as-possible condition. There must be remote (NOT near the visitors' center) parking for buses and cars during the summer. An electric shuttle system will keep harmful exhaust fumes away from the area. The only possible motorized boats on the lake should be electric, NO fossil fuels to contaminate the lake. Bus parking MUST NOT be expanded near the visitors' center, and all management must focus on climate change, sustainability and renewable energy. There must be absolutely NO consideration of moving the course of any existing waterway!

We need to present a positive view towards the future and help all our visitors take home a message that our wild, natural areas must be protected.
