Dear Forest Service:


I am responding as an objector for the Landscape Vegetation Analysis Project (LaVA) on the Medicine Bow National Forest. I have studied the information and reviewed my previous letter. There are three things that I would like to mention. 95,000 acres open for clear cutting shocks me. 600 miles of roads shocks me. Wildlife habitat loss shocks me.

I looked at Table I in the final environmental impact statement. It may make a lot of sense to foresters but it left me wondering if they had just read Smartest Guys in the Room.

The statement pertaining to objectors: "objector believes the environmental analysis or draft decision specifically violates law, regulation or policy." This statement must not apply to the average citizen, since the language appears to be a code known only between forestry managers. How would I know whether or not there was a violation of law, regulation or policy? Your comment period must be only for a select group.
