Statement of issues and/or parts of the plan revision to which the objection applies:

Overall revised plan does not comport with recent Sec. Of Ag memo on increasing access and productive use of CGNF. Does not comport with Organic Act of 1897 either.

Concise statement explaining the objection and suggestion how the proposed plan should be improved:

- The reasons for this objection are: Over 1/3 (1 million acres) of CGNF is already set aside by congress as wilderness. Another 850,000 acres are designated as Roadless areas. Good luck trying to do something other than walking there. Now we have another 200,000 acres of Backcountry Areas. Thus 2 million acres effectively removed from production. 1/4 million acres set aside as Recreation Emphasis Areas. No production there. This leaves 750,000 acres (25%) for all commodity production, and multiple use. Just tell me CGNF didn't sit down with a room full of wilderness, wildlife preservationists and recreationists. This does not comport with Organic act of 1897.
- Proposed Solution:
Wait until after election. If Trump is re-elected, start from scratch.
