Thank you for the opportunity to express my support of the Stibnite Gold Project in Valley County. I am a realtor based out of Canyon County but have had the chance work on properties in several of the surrounding counties around Valley County.

Over the last decade, Midas Gold has proven itself a leader in the mining industry and has proven to be a community supporter. From the beginning, Midas Gold Idaho has positioned themselves as a partner to local economies. Through the life of their project, Midas Gold has committed to hiring, contracting, and purchasing supplies and services locally whenever possible. That commitment is evident given that Midas Gold has spent over \$69 million in Idaho already by prioritizing local vendors and contractors.
