Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback on the Stibnite Gold Project as part of Midas Gold Idaho's comment period. I have been closely following Midas Gold Idaho's plans since they first came into our state, in large part because much of the proposed project will take place on public land. It was important to me that Midas Gold found a safe access route to the site during construction and operations. I feel confident in the company's plan to use Burntlog Road and limit the number of daily trips, as outlined under alternative 2.
