Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback on the Stibnite Gold Project as part of the public permitting process. I know this project will have a positive impact on the environment, communities surrounding the site and Idahoans.

It is critical that the US government allow projects like Stibnite to proceed. The US is home to abundant critical mineral deposits containing elements society needs in quantities that will only rise in the future. Sourcing these necessary elements from within the US must be done for many reasons. First and foremost, sourcing critical minerals in the US is the least environmentally damaging option for mining. The environmental regulatory regime in the US is second to none thereby ensuring that minerals we all need are provided in a manner that minimizes global environmental impact.
