I am proud of the recreational opportunities and outdoor beauty Idaho has to offer. I live in Valley County, a rural community that is home to historic mining operations dating back to the 1800s. The consequences of these earlier mining efforts were never addressed and will either go unaddressed or local taxpayers will be responsible for funding the cleanup. Fortunately, Midas Gold's Alternative 2 plan proposes clean up methods for the historic mining district. I am writing to urge you to vote yes on Alternative 2, a proposal that will stimulate our local economy and conserve our environment.

Communities across the nation are hurting from the COVID-19 pandemic. Many workers experienced job loss or a reduction in hours, and our economies are suffering.
