Thank you for allowing me to comment on such a vital and worthwhile project. The Stibnite Gold Project proposed by Midas Gold Idaho is one of the most beneficial business proposals to come to our regions in years. It is sure to help support a strong economy while ensuring environmentally-friendly practices and remediation of any damages to our natural surroundings, including any prior damages not caused by Midas Gold. After reviewing the draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), I strongly support the plan that Midas Gold has put forward in their modified Plan of Restoration and Operations (MOD PRO).

The Stibnite region is no stranger to mining operations, however, past miners have left the area in disrepair and in need of a great deal of environmental remediation. Notably, fish migration has been obstructed for over 80 years, yet, Midas Gold's plan examined in the EIS will include removing existing barriers to fish migration and re-establish salmon and steelhead passage to the headwaters of the East Fork of the South Fork of the Salmon River, thus reestablishing the fish's habitat and spawning areas.
