14		the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on

17		Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
18	WHEREAS,	Barksdale Resources Corporation, a mining company, has proposed the San
19		Antonio Exploration Drilling Project in the Patagonia Mountains south of the San
20		Xavier District of the Tohono O'odham Nation to focus on the untested, shallow
21		Cosmos porphyry copper target ("Project"); and
22	WHEREAS,	because the San Antonio Exploration Drilling Project is located within the
23		Coronado National Forest administered by the U.S. Forest Service, the U.S. Forest
24		Service issued a public Scoping Notice on September 2, 2020 seeking comments,
25		concerns, questions and suggestions from the public; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Government Comment Guidelines requires Legislative Council
27		approval of written comments submitted on the Nation's behalf to federal, state,
28		and local governments on proposed rules, regulations, laws, and proposed
29		actions that may affect the Nation (Section 3101, 1 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter
