The Stibnite Gold Project is a huge opportunity for Idaho and our country.

During my time with Western States CAT, I have learned about this critical minerals project at Stibnite. It abundantly clear to me that is a comprehensive project with unique solutions that will help our economy and our country.

While the site is rich in gold deposits it also has deposits of antimony – a mineral designated critical by the U.S. government.
