I am writing this letter in regards to the current proposal WR-26 and more specifically Bear Creek Road (FS-501)!

I appreciate this "open comment period" and value the consideration you are giving to forest travel management.

In regards to the proposed action to limit access on Bear Creek Road to ATVs (< 65" wide), I urge you and your colleagues to give consideration to a prescribed period (2-3 years) where limited seasonal access be put in place (particularly wet season - early spring).

After establishing a period of study, with attention to restricted traffic in the wet season, a mindful decision with data in hand could be made with attention to impact upon the riparian & wetland regions under consideration.

I believe that such a staged thoughtful analysis of data collected from the field would serve all concerned.

Frankly, allowing only ATVs (<65" wide) will likely promote (a) larger number of vehicles on the road and without seasonal restrictions may exacerbate road rutting & local environmental damage.

Finally,

For those individuals that derive their income from recreational outfitting, such as Bear Basin Adventures, a road restriction action now without thoughtful study would impose a significant financial hardship!
