Thank you to Shoshone National Forest for your work in managing our public land. This is a vital and important endeavor. I would especially like to thank you for:

- understanding your niche as a “backcountry forest”.
- No additional motorized routes in the Wiggins Roadless Area
- Balancing non-motorized winter recreation at Deception Creek

These are important implements in your plan. Please keep up the good work!

However, there is much to be done in other areas. Please consider these requests in your plan:

- Please enforce and maintain existing route systems before adding new motorized trails.
- Provide a plan for adequate staffing and a secured budget for signing, closing and decommissioning unauthorized routes under a set, timely deadline.
- Promote and maintain the South Zone’s already outstanding loop opportunities—**quantity over quality!**
- Provide access TO, not THROUGH, using single roads that cause less negative impact to wildlife habitat than loop routes.

Please keep in mind that 75% of individual Wyoming commenters on the Forest Plan opposed additional motorized development on the forest; You must reciprocate the desires of the public! I find it incredibly unfortunate to have a noise machine and pollutant near me when I am hiking.

Also, travel monitoring needs to document more illegal and unauthorized motorized use in areas with the highest road density. More roads and more loops= more illegal use. I do not wish any more roads!

As a life time resident of Wyoming and science teacher, I hope you consider my comments in your plan.
