Dear Sirs,

Please consider my concerns regarding some proposed new road closures in the Travel Management plan. I do not think the rigid scheduling of calendar dates for road closures is the proper way to serve forest users. Generally, current conditions may often be suitable for use without watershed damage during the proposed closed periods. Specifically, the proposed closure of Phelps Mountain until July 1, would eliminate access to Franc's Peak, one of the premiere backcountry ski destinations on the forest, during the suitable season. Many trips there have caused no adverse effect on wildlife or significant road or watershed damage. I also would hate to lose access up the Corral Creek and Monument Hill roads.
