Snowmobiles and skiers (especially since there is such a big influx of both when the highway opens around Memorial Day), don't mix well in that area. They need to be separated in high use areas like the Gardiner headwall, Reefer Ridge, 57 Chevy Couloir, and other areas. Snowmobiles can operate away from these high use areas and find thousands of great acres to drive, high point and otherwise find quality snow.

Keeping snowmobiles separate from popular skiing areas will enhance enjoyment of the experience for all.
