[REDACTED] have a love for all of Wyoming's outdoor activities. My husband and I are avid snowmobilers and spend every possible weekend enjoying all that Wyoming has to offer.

**Proposed Width Restriction on Groomed Snowmobile Trails**

I support the Revised PA to 'Prohibit tracked over snow vehicles wider than untracked 64" wheelbases from using groomed snowmobile trails.' I understand this to mean full-sized motor vehicles equipped with a track conversion kit will be prohibited on groomed trails, while large side-by-side UTVs will be allowed – recognizing that a 64" wheelbase UTV will be 9" o 12" wider (73" to 76" total width) when equipped with a track conversion kit.

**Proposed Motorized Use Period 'Zone Boundaries'**

I strongly disagree with the proposed Low Elevation and High Elevation use period 'zone boundaries'. The Wyoming winters vary from year to year and to create an arbitrary date of when the snowmobiling season should end is illogical.
