I am writing to add my support for the Wyoming State Snowmobile Associations stance on the issues. Elevation zone and use period restrictions needlessly complicate the issue and are not supported by snowtel data. Also, in a good snow year it would seem that you would be unable to reach the "legal" zone. There should be no snow depth requirements on a trail that is open to ATV use in the rest of the season. Quite often in late season it is necessary to unload at a spot where there is several feet of snow, but further in there may be patches where there is no snow. I do not see how riding a snowmobile on the road or designated trail with minimal snow will cause damage to the road or why it should be no allowed.
