Please consider the following regarding:

WR-83 Conversion of roads in Burroughs Creek Area to OHV trails

OPPOSE

This is a bad idea and one which will create significant issues for the forest service and the public.

1. Enforcement of this requirement will be a headache for the FS. Enforcement is already one of the biggest administrative problems in the travel management plan. You simply do not have the personnel.
2. This requirement is sure to antagonize the public- you don't need the bad PR.
3. Underage drivers- (non licensed) will create a hazard on the Horse Creek road. Sections of this proposed "trail" are roads not trails- not a good place for younger drivers.
4. Brent Creek road is heavily used by hunters in the fall- enforcement again an issue. And an unreasonable requirement.
