

To the Shoshone National Forest Travel Management Team,

I would like to comment on the Youth opportunity for motorized travel. I do not think that there is enough opportunity for youth added in the current proposals. I submitted proposals for open youth riding areas at the Pilot Creek gravel pit, and the Ghost Creek gravel pit. Both of those have camping areas adjacent to them, and nearby riding areas for adults, fishing access etc. The Pilot Creek area is near the highway, so noise should not be a concern, and it has toilet facilities. It is far enough from the equestrian trail head, that there should be no conflicts. I do not see this proposal even on the list. I would like to see it added. I would also like to see the Morrison jeep trail or a portion added to the trail system. It is the perfect area for youth to ride. It has no logging, ever. The full sized vehicles are traveling very slowly, due to the conditions; there is camping nearby, etc. Perhaps only the upper portion should be considered.
