Proposed Width Restriction on Groomed Snowmobile Trails

I support the Revised PA to ‘Prohibit tracked over snow vehicles wider than untracked 64” as long as this allows side-by-side UTVs– recognizing that a 64” wheelbase UTV will be 9” o 12” wider (73” to 76” total width) when equipped with a track conversion kit.

Proposed Motorized Use Period ‘Zone Boundaries’

I strongly disagree with the proposed Low Elevation and High Elevation use period ‘zone boundaries’. We routinely have late and long winters where there is plenty of snow to ride past the proposed dates
