**Subject:** DUBOIS USFS TRAILS

To whom it may concern,

[REDACTED]. I was told by my neighbors who were in attendance at your recent "town hall" meeting the Forest Service wants to restrict access on trails near our property by closing down motorized vehicle traffic altogether on WR-02W and WR-03W. I do not support this as this would restrict my winter access to public lands and would not allow me to visit the Brooks Lake Area in the winter. I understand that the service wants to shut down these trails to motorized traffic for snow shoe/ cross country skiing. I believe cross country and motorized vehicles can co-exist on this trail system, However- If they cannot co-exist, motorized vehicles in this area are definitely the majority and thus should have its benefits as such and not be changed.

Additionally, I support increasing Trail WR-27 motorized vehicle width to 64 inches wide vice 50', the majority of the folks in the area have 4 person side by sides that measure greater than 50'.
