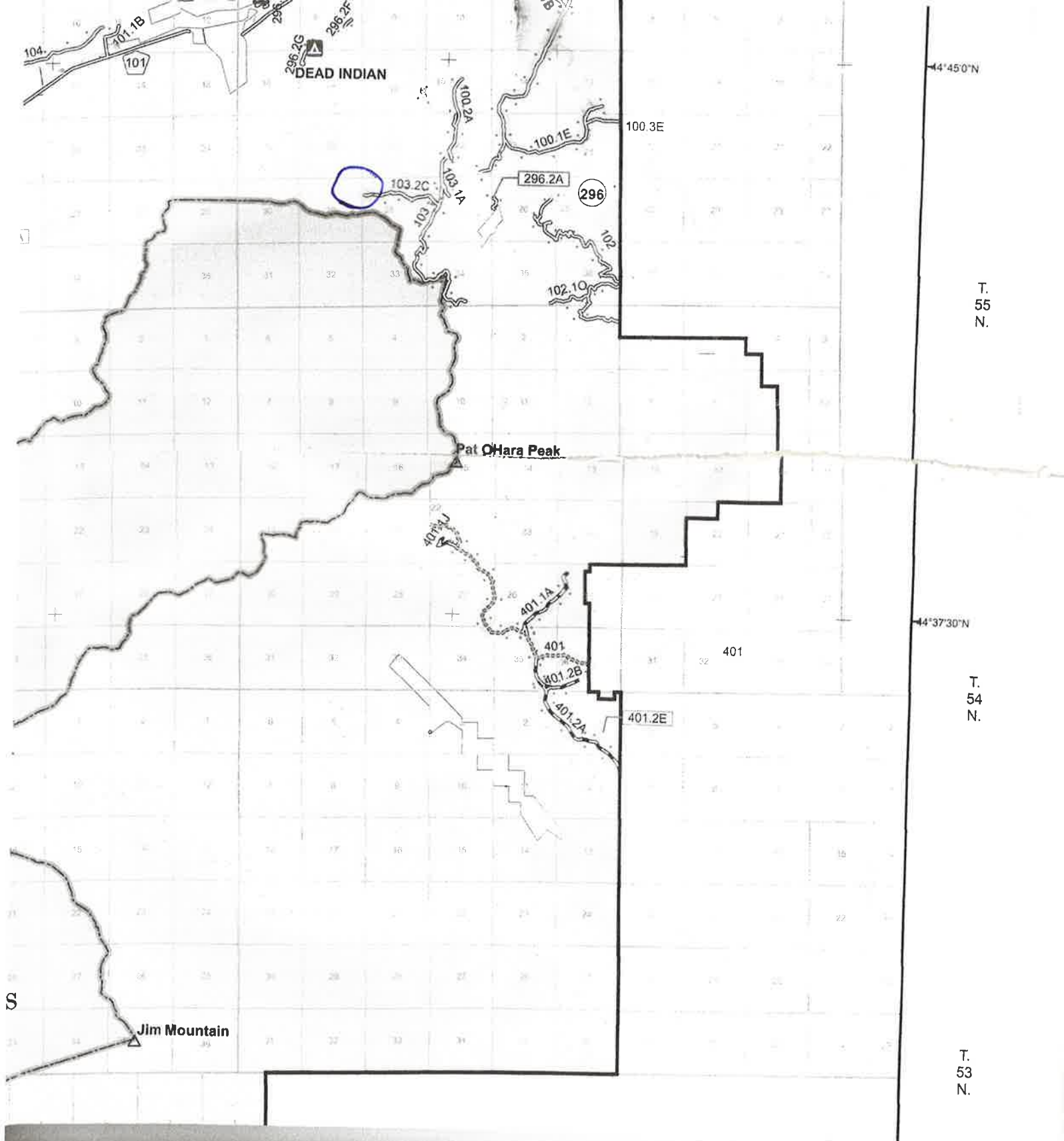
103 is off Hwy 296 Chief Joseph Highway before the Dead Indian Summit; 103.2C branches off 103 and goes west for approximately one mile. 103.2C was closed at its existing closure in 2014 without public notice.

3. Why is your proposal desired or needed?

This area is excellent hunting for elderly hunters because of the existing trails, easy access, and safely travel with 4 wheelers and all ATV. It is also beautiful scenery for 4-wheeling in the summer time. The trails stop well before approaching Wilderness. Re-opening 103.2C for approximately 3/4 mile west from the existing closure would give access to the existing trails in that area. Re-open to ATVs.
