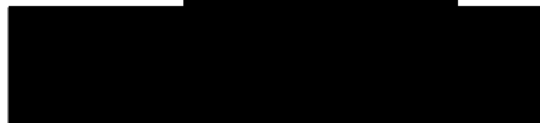

HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION INPUT TO SHOSHONE NATIONAL FOREST TRAVEL MANAGEMENT

There are two USFS roads that are accessed through our subdivision :
FS road # 554, also referred to as Wildcat road and FS road # 545, also referred to as Geyser road.

Each of these roads have parking areas that border the private property of the subdivision.

They are very heavily used since they offer the easiest and closest access to forest lands from the town of Dubois.

Both of these parking areas are in dire need of additional signage that would inform visitors that there is no overnight camping allowed, no shooting, and no camp fires. The recreational use of firearms at these locations is especially dangerous because of the close proximity to residential housing.

A short way up the Wildcat road # 554 is the intersection where FS road # 962, also referred to as Tower Mountain road, takes off.

It is gated and is signed as closed to ATV/ORV use .

People routinely drive around the gate because there is no adequate barricade in place. It would be a simple matter to install a non-moveable barricade on either side of the gate.

On the 2015 ORV Trails Map there is a mis-marked open route (green) that mistakenly guides the public down a dead end private subdivision road which does not provide access to USFS or BLM lands.

This needs to be excluded from the ORV Map.

According to the map it is either Spruce Lane or Bachelor Ct. in the ULWS subdivision.
