New Proposals

1. What is the proposal? - Education

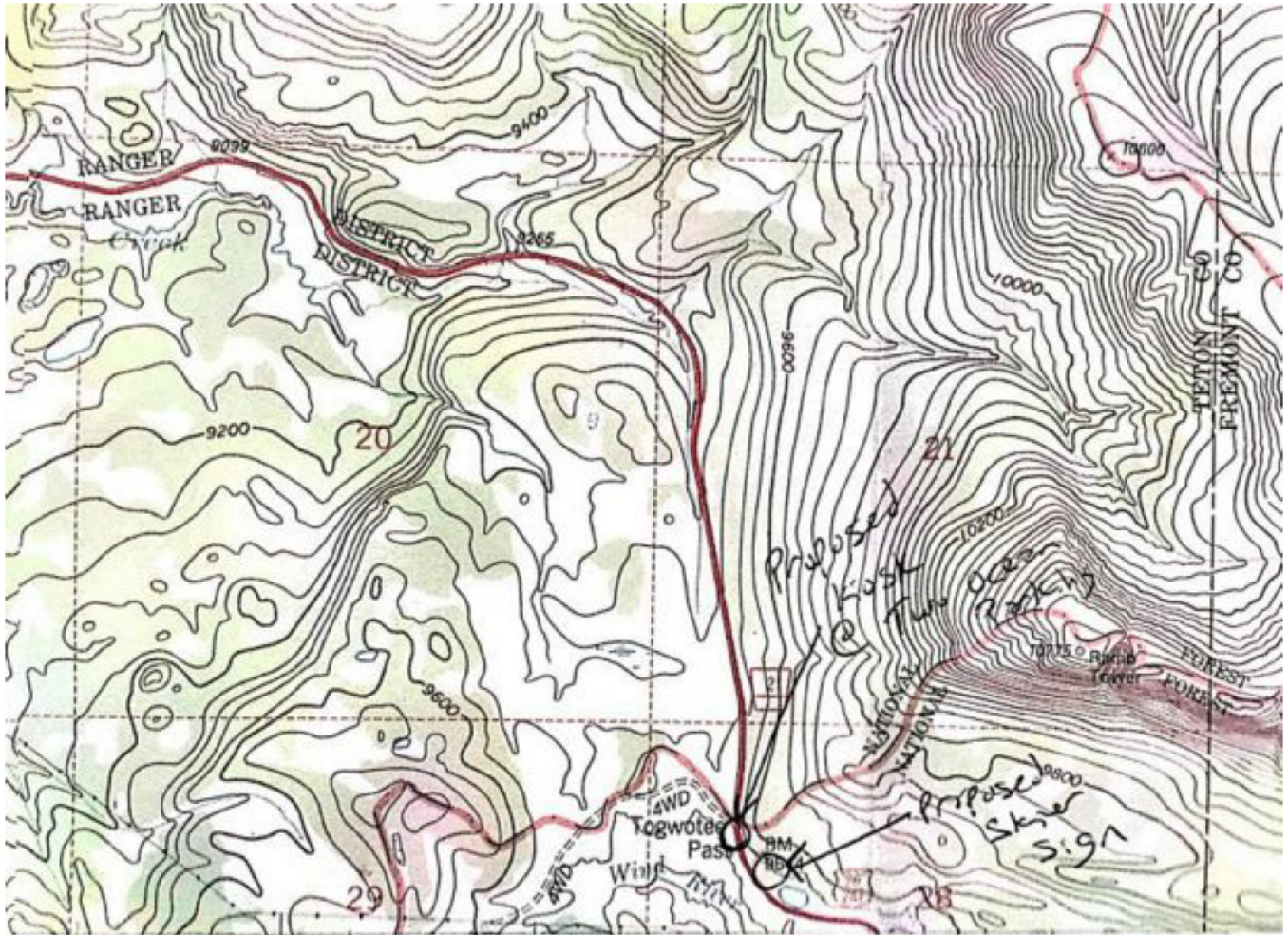
We propose for some sort of informational kiosk for skier and snowmobiler education. Ideally these signs would be in heavy use areas (i.e. Parking lot at Two Ocean) This kiosk would have clearly marked maps to show motorized vs. non-motorized zones, and designated snowmobile trails. Ideally, it would also have avalanche risk information, proper etiquette when traveling in the backcountry (skiers and snowmobilers), LNT principles, and a beacon check station. It could look something like this.



There is currently a brown snowmobile sign at the Two Ocean parking lot. What about a skier one at popular parking areas? We hope that all users can be informed what is offered on the pass. Also, it lets other user groups know who they may encounter on the trail. It would be our hope to collaborate with local snowmobile groups to decide what will be on the sign.

2. Where is the proposal located?

Two Ocean Parking Lot (43.75274° N 110.06832° W) (Map included). On the left if heading to Jackson



3. Why is your proposal desired or needed?

Keeping all user groups informed will better enforce wilderness boundary closures to motorized vehicles, avalanche awareness will better prepare user groups, and lastly it will keep all user groups informed of who will be encountered on their trip and how to respect everyone's experience, motorized or not.
