Thanks for the update. Just so you are aware, the coordinators of the Cody Wild West River Fest have been gathering feedback from river users related to access to the North Fork - some of which is relevant to USFS Travel Management. It's not ready yet, but we're working to create a digital map (with photos and comments) that will show both the locations and amenities of existing access points to the river as well as the same for river access points that the community desires on the Forest. The sites span from Sleeping Giant down to the Horse Creek day use area, so if there's an opportunity yet this summer to add a field trip to review river access via the Forest, we'd love to get that on the books.

Greetings, here is a quick update about Travel Management on the North Zone –

<!--[if !supportLists]-->✓ <!--[endif]-->I would like to thank those of you who attended the field trip to the Line Creek area on August 5th; we had good representation from the Forest Service, GYC, NW OHV Alliance, WY State Trails and the Backcountry Horsemen. It was a good discussion and I look forward to more like it.

We had planned to meet down in the Gooseberry Creek area but have postponed that trip due to conflicts with a contracted vegetation management project that's going on. Instead we will meet at the Sawtooth Lake Trailhead to review a proposal to connect the Sawtooth Lake Road and the 120 Road. This will be an ATV ride (can't take a pickup and survive the bumpy road to Sawtooth, I tried) with a mile or 2 of walking. You'll have to arrange your own transportation. Bring personal protective equipment, lunch and water. Our contact person for the trip is Kristie Salzmann [REDACTED].
