The East Boulder Mine Plan of Operations for a tailing ponds expansion has me, a resident of Big Timber since 1972, extremely concerned.

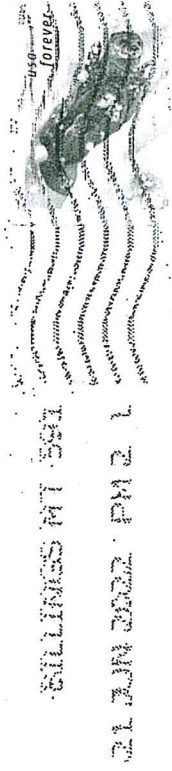
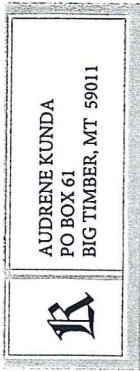
