Perpetua Resources' Stibnite Gold Project presents Idaho, particularly rural Idaho, with a huge economic and environmental opportunity. The company has a plan to improve water quality, wetlands, and the river and leave the site better than it is today. I am writing to the U.S. Forest Service, in order to encourage with absolute sincerity the Permitting of this project.

The Stibnite project is particularly important to me because, as a side-benefit of mining for gold (Au) this project will strengthen national security through the production of ANTIMONY. Antimony is used to make electronics and batteries and is also a critical mineral for national defense and the energy industry. Right now, the U.S. relies solely on foreign countries for this mineral. This is a precarious situation we need to rectify, now.

The project at Stibnite could produce over 100 million pounds of antimony and become our only domestically mined source.
