

I am writing to express my disgust for Perpetua Resources and the Stibnite Gold Project. The project would add more pollution and destroy wildlife and sully America's future. I encourage you to NOT adopt the proposed activities outlined in the company's 2021 Modified Mine Plan during the permitting process.

I DO NOT support the Stibnite Gold Project. Perpetua Resources' proposed project would destroy over 20% of critical habitat for chinook and bull trout in the project area. It presents a terrible opportunity to give this area of Idaho's backcountry the environmental attention it needs, while also securing a domestic source of the critical mineral antimony. Over 70% of the project disturbance would occur on public land. The Stibnite Gold Project puts the Salmon River at risk, one of our most cherished and economically important river systems. It threatens our recreation industry and some of our most iconic fish species.

This is terrible misuse of public resources. Do not allow it.
