

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the plans for the Stibnite Gold Project. Over the last several years, I've had the opportunity to hear a handful of presentations on the project, sit down with members of Perpetua Resources and observe how the company has lived out its mission as it has grown. It is with this knowledge that I encourage you to move the project forward.

Although I am supportive of the Stibnite project and the benefits to our economy, I am concerned about the increased traffic and safety on Warm Lake. I reside among the residential area, 3 miles from Highway 55. Our Road, Pearsol Loop, enters Warm Lake on corners that have very low visibility. In the winter with current speeds at 50 mph and icy roads, it is already a hazard; increased traffic to and from the Stibnite staging/parking area will surely make this area more dangerous. I strongly urge you to investigate this stretch of road yourself and discuss solutions with the residents, ie. turning lane or lowering the speed limit.
