Close and decommission forest roads.

Further analyze impacts of thinning and prescribed burning on Mexican Spotted Owls. The analysis in the EA is inadequate.

Do not masticate trees.

Reduce the amount of smoke from this project by 75%.

Do not thin in Inventoried Roadless Areas.
