Our children recently purchased twenty six acres of land here as well. It is the beauty and unspoiled environment that has always attracted our family to this area. With the proposed thirty nine drilling sites covering thousands of square feet each, mining is sure to follow, despite claims to the contrary. Although doubtful that we would see an impact in our lifetimes, generations to come would almost certainly see the cultural heritage of the Black Hills compromised. We do not understand how oversight and monitoring of this project could prevent that from eventually happening. Despite a hoped-for economic boost that this project proposes to offer, we feel that it is outweighed by the negative impact on the environment of this sacred land. The integrity of the Black Hills is not for sale.
