Dear Supervisor Upton,

We write to urge you to extend the upcoming comment period on the Wild & Scenic Rivers and Wilderness inventories currently scheduled for April 17-May 1.

Wilderness and Wild & Scenic Rivers are two of the critical components of the Revision EIS. Fourteen days is far too short for an issue of this importance and we request that you extend the comment period by at least 16 days for a total of 30 days.

We understand there will be additional opportunities for public comment but at this formative stage of development it is critical that the public be afforded an adequate period of time to evaluate the work of the Forest Service.
