Dear U.S. Forest Service Chief Randy Moore,

We, the undersigned, are writing to thank you and express our full-hearted support for your proposal to conserve and steward old-growth forests on national forests and grasslands by amending forest management plans nationwide in accordance with President Biden's Executive Order.

Under the deeply flawed Nantahala-Pisgah National Forest management plan that was adopted early in 2023, more than 100,000 acres of old-growth forests, natural heritage areas, roadless areas, and sensitive habitats were placed in zones that are open to commercial logging. We ask that the management plan be amended to protect these areas of old-growth and mature forest from commercial logging and emphasize the restoration of wildfire resilience and old-growth characteristics across the plan area.
