- 1. How many non-motorized users utilize Granite Mountain due to the snowmobile closure, besides the commercial cat ski program?
- 2. What are the daily, weekly, and season totals of cat ski users?
- 3. Why do we not have any comments from the cat ski program?
- 4. How many snowmobile incursions are there, and where?
- 5. What does the cat ski program pay the Forest Service to be the sole user of Granite Mt.?

In reviewing the comments, you can see that at least 90% do not support any closure of Granite Mt to snowmobiles.

Whoever in the Forest Service that came up with the full-time closure of Granite Mt. idea without gathering facts and presenting them in the analysis, did the Forest Service a big disservice.
