Hi Nick,

Thanks for the quick response and detailed explanation. I guess the issue I'm having is that while reviewing the draft EA, I noticed it repeatedly relies on the BA "and says several times that there is more detail" in the BA and that effects on species are only "summarized" in the draft EA. I understand that the BA isn't in a final form quite yet, and I get that the Forest Service still needs to check in with NPS, but CEQ regs require agencies to make materials incorporated by reference "available for review" during the public comment period. 40 C.F.R. § 1501.12. Is there any way you could share the version of the BA that the draft EA relied on?

I totally understand that a lot of the information shared between the BA and draft EA is duplicative.

I'm just trying to do my due diligence to understand what, if anything, I might be missing so I can better comment on the proposal.

Hey, Spencer. Thanks for reaching out. I'll be here at the Grandfather meeting on Monday. Hopefully we see you there.

So, the Draft BA was just shared with FWS this week. NPS also wants some additional input/review since their a cooperating agency. Unfortunately it will be deliberative until it's finalized. We expect that it will be available when the final EA/Draft Decision are out. The EA lists the species considered, summarizes the effects, and lists out the conservation measures/design features. Is there a particular species or measure that you're interested in? I might be able to address your concern with something I can share, as you know a lot of this info duplicative, from a host of different sources, or I can give our folks ahead up as they are discussing the BA with FWS and NPS.
