What I am looking for is the monitoring efforts about the recommendations for road closures in various sub basins - are there maps that show the changes in road densities as a result of the closures and decommissioning efforts. This would also potentially change the interior forest patch sizes.

Another issue is the canopy closure and connectivity recommendations - 40% is too open for multiple species - NSO and Marten as examples - not sure if you attended Dr. Brenda McComb's presentation ?

If I remember correctly the deadline for my comments is Sept 11th - correct?
