Please protect our welling military from harm. Please approve our request for a 20 yr. mineral withdrawal.

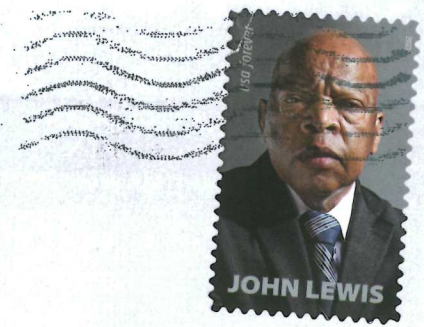
