We write to you today to express our concerns regarding the recent release of the Draft Decision Notice (DDN) and Finding of No Significant Impacts (FONSI) for the proposed Buffalo Springs Restoration Project in Orange and Crawford counties in Indiana. We have followed the developments of this proposed action on the Hoosier National Forest. Our concerns for our health, our economy and infrastructure are as follows:

- Protecting roads, bridges, and other critical infrastructures from damaging Forest Service activities associated with the project,
