Moving the termination point of 439 to the west would allow the Forest Service to adequately protect the properties during the burn and replace the burn with mechanical methods. See arrow pointing SE from 439.

Moving the roadless area south by 200 meters would allow the property owners to create a trail from 439 via a special use permit enabling the landowners to protect lives and property. Note: this is an extremely rugged area and a trail through the current roadless area would be necessary to service the members of Triangle Trail.

The black/white line is the North Country trail which the forest service has planned for new constructed in the same area.
